## Volleyball Competition Rules

### 1. Location

The Volleyball competition will take place at the University of South Australia's Magill Campus, inside the stadium.

### 2. Time

The competition will be held between 12:00pm-2:00pm on Friday 25 August 2017.

### 3. Team size

**3.1** Each school/unit may enter a maximum of two (2) teams; one staff and one student team or a mixed team of staff and students.

**3.2** Each team shall be made up of a minimum of six (6) players with a maximum of eight (8) players.

**3.3** There are no minimum or maximum number of male and female team members.

### 4. Match Duration

Each game will last 15 minutes. If at the end of time the score is a tie, then an extra point will be played to determine the winner.

### 5. Points score

**5.1** Points for each match shall be awarded as follow:

- Winning team: 3 points
- Losing team : 1 point
- Forfeited team: 0 points

**5.2** *Pool Round to Finals* – if there is a tie in total points at the end of the pool rounds, the highest ranked team will be the one with the most points for. If this is even, then it will be based on least points against. If it is still a tie then the highest ranked team will be based on the winner of the head to head contest.

### 6. Forfeits

A forfeit will be declared ten (10) minutes after the scheduled start of play time where either team is unable to commence play.

### 7. Uniform requirements

Teams are to select their own uniform, but are not necessary for this competition. Appropriate flat soled footwear must be worn at all times.

## **8. Team Duties**

**8.1** The duty team will be required to keep score during the match and then complete the scorecard at the end of the match and hand it to the event organiser.

**8.2** The person fulfilling the team duty requirements can be any competent person associated with that team and not necessarily have to be a player e.g. Team manager.

Presentations shall be conducted at the conclusion of the competition.
