UniSA Sport Social Sports 2017 Terms and Conditions

Sports

UniSA Sport offers weekly team competitions in a variety of sports, including; 3x3 Basketball, Futsal, Rugby 7's, Indoor Volleyball 6's. Our goal is to provide daytime sports programs that are well run, competitive, yet very social.

UniSA Sport Membership

All players participating in the social sport competitions must be a current member of UniSA Sport. Membership for students is free and \$22 annually for staff, community and alumni.

Team Nominations

Nominations should be received prior to the closing date as late applications will only be accepted if there is a shortage of teams for that sport. Should nominations exceed the space available, places will be allocated on a first in basis. Teams may transfer to another sport if the original sport is full/not running as long as this is before the beginning of the competition and space is available. The UniSA Sport Facility Coordinator reserves the right to accept or reject any nomination received.

Duties of Team Captain

Upon signing the team nomination form the captain (as on the nomination form) agrees to be **personally liable** for any fines that may be imposed upon the team as a result of the team forfeiting a game or withdrawing from the competition. The team captain is responsible for ensuring game fees are paid in full prior to the scheduled game start time. Teams will not be permitted to play unless payment is made in full. Failure to do so will result in a late start and teams will be penalised with points or goals deducted as appropriate (refer to the UniSA Sport Specific Rules and Regulations on our website).

Dress Standards

Appropriate sporting attire must be worn during play. All teams are required to be in a common team shirt (the same colour) by the second week of competition (refer to the UniSA Sports Specific Rules and Regulations on our website). The Sports Program Officer reserves the right to determine whether team strips are suitable. Single colour bibs will be provided where team colours clash. Only non-marking sports shoes in good condition must be worn. Players not in correct shoes will not be allowed to participate.

Liability

Players participate in the competition at their own risk and UniSA Sport will not be liable for incidental injuries incurred.

Player Shortages

Players **MUST** be registered to the team they play for. Fill-ins can be sourced throughout the season to help field teams. To avoid swapping and bias players **MUST** only be registered to one team in each sport. In the case of finals, a player must have played **at least 20% of scheduled games** for their team to be eligible to play.

Season Fixturing

Team captains will be emailed the entire season fixture before the first game. All teams should expect an even spread of time slots over the season. Fixtures will only be changed during the season if the UniSA Sport Facility Coordinator agrees.

Forfeits

A game will be declared a forfeit when:

- A team is not ready to play within (5) five minutes of the scheduled start time;
- A team fails to honour their fixtured game (this includes finals).

Any team forfeiting will incur the following fines:

- Any team that has notified the Sports Program Officer (Mawson Lakes: mawsonlakessportscentre@unisa.edu.au or 8302 3257, Magill: magillsportscentre@unisa.edu.au or 83022560) by 10.00am the day of the fixture: **Normal game fee for that chosen sport.**
- Any team that does not show up to a fixtured game without notifying the Sports Program Officer prior to 10.00am the day of their fixture will be charged **twice (2x) the Normal Game fee for that chosen sport. This is referred to as a 'NO SHOW FEE'**. This fee is in place to ensure opposition teams can be given fair warning so please be courteous and considerate of others.

Should a team forfeit their game, the forfeit fee must be paid before their scheduled game the following week. Teams who fail to pay their forfeit fine will not be permitted to take the court until such time as they pay the forfeit fine in full. Teams whose payments are up to date prior to their last game will receive their last game free as part of the fee paid at the time of registration.

Team Withdrawals

A team withdrawing from the competition will be subject to a **withdrawal fee of \$100** plus any outstanding fees incurred prior to withdrawal.

Photo and Video Rights

UniSA Sport retain the right to use photos and video footage taken of players for marketing purposes unless requested not to by writing to the UniSA Sport Facility Coordinator.

Umpires

Umpires are provided by UniSA Sport for all games. UniSA Sport Umpires are there to do their job and any kind of aggressive or bullying behaviour towards them by any person; player or supporter or bystander will receive a first and final warning or asked to leave the Stadium/Oval and evicted from the competition. If this behaviour comes from a player, a fine may be issued to the team by the UniSA Sport Facility Coordinator.

Conduct and Behaviour

All teams, players and spectators at UniSA Sport Stadiums must abide by these Terms and Conditions and the UniSA Sport Code of Conduct. These conditions are in place to ensure everyone can enjoy their sport. Our referees, umpires and staff do their utmost to provide a friendly and professional sporting environment and we expect the same from our participants. Abusive language or behaviour will not be tolerated and UniSA Sport staff will act swiftly to impose penalties for misconduct. UniSA Sport staff reserves the right to evict any individual or team from the competition during the season due to misconduct. If a player is under the influence of alcohol they will not be permitted to play and could be subject to being evicted from the Stadium/oval and the competition. Brawls or conflicts of any nature will not be tolerated. Any team involved will be permanently evicted from UniSA Sport Stadiums including any of its social competitions and will be liable to pay for any damages.
